1st Reading - Isaiah 45:1, 4-6

1 Thus says the Lord to my anointed Cyrus, whose right hand I hold, so that I may subjugate the nations before his face, and I may turn the backs of kings, and I may open the doors before him, and so that the gates will not be shut.

4 For the sake of Jacob, my servant, and Israel, my elect, I have even called

you by your name. I have taken you up, and you have not known me.

18 Knowing their malice, Jesus said, "Why are you testing me, you hypocrites?


19 Show me the coin that pays the census tax." Then they handed him the Roman coin.
